The Handmaid's Tale by Margaret Atwood

- 1. What is the function of the epigraphs at the beginning of the novel?
- 2. In Gilead, women are categorized as wives, handmaids, Marthas, or Aunts, but Moira refuses to fit into a niche. Trace Moira's role throughout the story to determine what she symbolizes.
- 3. Aunt Lydia, Janine, and Offred's mother represent more than themselves. What do each of their characters signify? What do the style and colour of their clothes symbolize?
- 4. The Commander in the novel says you can't cheat nature. How do characters find ways to follow their natural instincts?
- 5. Babies are referred to as "a keeper," "unbabies," or "shredders." What other real or fictional worlds do these terms suggest?
- 6. Why is the Bible under lock and key in Gilead?
- 7. A palimpsest is a medieval parchment that scribes attempted to scrape clean and use again, though they were unable to obliterate all traces of the original. How does the new republic of Gilead's social order often resemble a palimpsest?
- 8. Atwood included historical notes at the end of the novel. Why do you think these were included, and how did they affect your interpretation of the story?
- 9. Margaret Atwood is often asked if the book is intended to be a feminist novel. Do you think it is? Why or why not?

Terms of Loan

- 12 copies are included in each kit.
- 6-week loan period.
- No renewals.
- Kit may be picked up at or returned to any CLMA library location.
- Kit must be returned at the service desk during operating hours, not through an exterior drop box.
- All items are checked out to one person's card.
- The person who borrowed the kit is responsible for:
 - The distribution and return of all items to their group members; and
 - Any damages to the books/bag, or lost items.
 - The cost of a damaged or lost book varies depending on the item.
