- 1. Shaker Heights is almost another character in the novel. Do you believe "the best communities are planned?" Why or why not?
- 2. There are many types of mother/daughter relationships in the novel. Which relationship did you find most interesting?
- 3. The fate of Mayling/Mirabelle is a multilayered and heartbreaking debate. Who do you think should raise her?
- 4. How is motherhood defined throughout the novel?
- 5. What, ultimately, bothers Elena most about Mia?
- 6. Pearl has led a singular life before arriving in Shaker, but once she meets the Richardson's, she has a chance to become normal. Is that a good thing?
- 7. What do you think about the conclusion of the book? Were you shocked by the ending?
- 8. The book is written from the perspective of different characters. How does the change of narrator affect the reader's experience of the novel?
- 9. Izzy chose, "this be the verse" to sum up her life. Based on Izzy's experience is the poem accurate?
- 10. What does the title and book dedication mean to you?

Terms of Loan

- 12 copies are included in each kit.
- 6-week loan period.
- No renewals.
- Kit may be picked up at or returned to any CLMA library location.
- Kit must be returned at the service desk during operating hours, not through an exterior drop box.
- All items are checked out to one person's card.
- The person who borrowed the kit is responsible for:
 - The distribution and return of all items to their group members; and
 - Any damages to the books/bag, or lost items.
 - The cost of a damaged or lost book varies depending on the item.
