We Were Dreamers: An Immigrant Superhero Origin Story by Simu Liu

- 1. Simu Liu is most well known for his character Shang Chi in the Marvel Universe, but many Canadians were introduced to him as a star of the television show *Kim's Convenience*. Were you already a fan of this actor before reading his memoir, and what is your favorite role that he played?
- 2. Did your opinion of Liu change after reading this book?
- 3. While this book is a celebrity memoir, the focus is not really about Liu's time in Hollywood a great deal of the book focuses on his background growing up in Canada as a son of immigrants. What part of the book did you enjoy the most?
- 4. What surprised you the most about the experiences Liu's family had in China?
- 5. The struggle of immigrant children to live up to the sacrifices made by parents striving to provide a better life is a well known one, particularly in Canada. What effect did this have on Liu?
- 6. Some people have criticized this book because Liu did not outline how he and his parents came to a resolution after so clearly outlining their past relationship. Do you think that more detail was needed? Why do you think that information was not included?
- 7. Even though Liu was ultimately successful at his acting career, how difficult would it be to encourage a child to pursue a career in acting when they are already trained as an accountant?
- 8. How much of Liu's success do you think he can credit to his parents or did he find success despite of them?
- 9. What was the most surprising detail you learned about the life of a working actor?
